Sub: Request for suggestions for the Union Budget of 2024-25

Dear Member exporters,

The Union Government has started the exercise of formulating the proposals for the Union Budget of 2024-25. In this regard, AEPC has received a communication from the Department of Commerce asking for its suggestions and views for the Budget in prescribed Proforma ([Click to View](#)).

To enable us to send considered suggestions to the Department of Commerce, you are requested to kindly send us your inputs in the prescribed Proforma on most urgent basis. The Department has requested that the budget proposals may be sent in the light of the following:

- The pre-budget proposals should be complete in all respects, properly categorized and HS Codes, wherever applicable, for each commodity must be provided.
- Justification given in favour of the proposal be restricted to 300 words and Annexures should be used, if necessary.
- Members may categorise proposals as 'Top Priority', 'Priority' and 'Common Proposals'.
- Issues discussed year after year but never agreed to, may not be raised again.
