**Subject: Extension of Last Date for Submitting applications for Scrip based FTP Schemes**

Please refer to AEPC Circular No. 68 dated 31/01/2022 informing that for all those shipping bills, where the date of filing is upto 31.12.2020, technical changes have been made in the portal of DGFT so that exporters can file their claims with DGFT, even if the LEO date for these shipping bills is on or after 01.01.2021. Since the DGFT portal opened up for such applications on 31st Jan 2022 and the exporters did not get sufficient time to file the applications before they got time barred on 31st Jan 2022 itself, Council again took up the matter for extension of such scrip based applications.

2. In this regard, we are happy to inform that the last date of submitting applications under MEIS, SEIS, ROSCTL, ROSL and 2% additional ad hoc incentive (under para 3.25 of FTP) which was earlier notified to be 31.01.2022 has been extended to 28.02.2022 vide DGFT Notification No. 53/2015-2022 dated 01/02/2022.

3. Please note that after 28.02.2022, no further applications would be allowed to be submitted and they would become time-barred. Late cut provisions shall also not be available for submitting claims at a later date.

4. The new late cut for applications submitted upto 28/02/2022 shall be:
