d) A session on “Realizing India’s Trillion Dollar Goal in Export” proposes to address issues in key sectors including Textiles, Additive Manufacturing and Robotic.

All Break-out Sessions are expected to lead to an Action Plan with timelines for the way forward, along with a monitoring framework, keeping in mind the announcements of the Union Budget.
